Walking Safaris in Tanzania and Kenya

Driving safaris are incredible, there's no doubt about that — but there's something truly special about wandering through the wilderness on your own two feet.

For travellers who want to slow things down and connect deeply with the land and wildlife around them, walking safaris strip away the vehicle and bring you face-to-face with the environment. Every track, bird call, or plant becomes part of the story.



The thrill lies not only in seeking out the Big Five, but in experiencing the wilderness at eye level, guided by experts who know how to read the land. On a walking safari, you aren't just passing through nature — you're part of it, step by step.

Where to go: Tarangire, Lake Manyara, and southern Tanzania are famous for walking safaris, but Kenya's Laikipia Plateau and the Mara conservancies also offer superb, guided walks.

Hot Air Balloon Safaris Over the Plains

Few experiences match the serenity of drifting above the plains at dawn, the golden sun spilling across the horizon as herds of wildebeest and elephants move silently below. A balloon safari adds a sense of grandeur and perspective that can only be truly appreciated once you've experienced it yourself.

To top it all off, most balloon safaris end with a decadent champagne breakfast in the bush — a memory to last a lifetime. Any journey through East Africa is special, but this is the very definition of a bucket-list moment.

Where to go: One of our favourites is the hot air balloon safari over Ruaha National Park, where you can take in breathtaking panoramic views of one of Tanzania's most unspoiled wilderness areas.



Air Safaris Across Kenya, Tanzania & Beyond

If you want to see more than one region, cover vast distances, and witness East Africa's dramatic contrasts in a single journey, an air safari is an ideal choice. Small aircraft connect iconic destinations — from Amboseli's elephant herds beneath Mount Kilimanjaro to the

Where to go: Multi-stop itineraries across Kenya and Tanzania, or even extending into Uganda and Rwanda, make for outstanding air safari adventures.

Water Safaris on East Africa's Rivers & Lakes

We've covered ground and air — but what about water? The rivers and lakes of East Africa offer yet another unique safari experience. A boat safari provides close-up encounters with hippos, crocodiles, and waterbirds, while also giving you a tranquil perspective of wildlife drawn to the shoreline.

The pace is slower, and the view is refreshingly different. Looking up to see elephants drinking at eye level from your canoe or boat is a moment you'll never forget.

Where to go: The Rufiji River in Nyerere National Park, Lake Naivasha in Kenya, and Uganda's Kazinga Channel in Queen Elizabeth National Park are all outstanding destinations for water safaris.
